PART 1 - Admissions to the 2021/2022 school year

Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2021/2022 Intake

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

<p>The school will commence accepting applications for admission on October 1st 2020. Enrolment Application Forms can be downloaded on the school website www.scoilbarranaofa.ie or can be obtained from the school office.</p>	
<p>The school shall cease accepting applications for admission at 15:00pm on October 31st 2020. In order for an application to be considered complete the parents of the applicant must provide;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fully completed application form, signed and dated, including the applicant's PPSN.• A copy of the applicant's Birth Certificate. An applicant must be at least 4 years of age on the first day of the school year for which he/she is seeking enrolment, however, the Board of Management recommends that applicants are at least four years of age on or before March 1st in the calendar year of proposed enrolment.• If availing of the priorities due to residence in one of the catchment areas, proof of address in the form of a utility bill in the name of	

one of the applicant's parent(s), which must be dated no later than three months prior to the date of the offer being made. Applications which are incomplete, not signed, not dated and/or do not include the required documentation will not be processed.	
The initial date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is November 30th 2020 .	
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is; 16:00pm on the date which falls two calendar weeks after the date of offer . Failure to accept a place within the two week time frame will result in the place being offered to the next applicant on the list.	

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
